PRE-FISH MARATHON - Information

1. The race is a 2-day race and the entry fee is therefore for both days. No one-day entries.
2. Compulsory portages - Day 1: Dam Wall, Brak River Weir, Prospect Bridge, Katkop Weir.
(Collett weir: Either go down double chute or portage **river right ONLY** - no portage open on left anymore. No access to chute for seconds at this stage.)
3. Compulsory portages - Day 2: Baroda Weir, Marlow Causeway
4. Finish of day 2 at the club jetty, approximately 200m downstream of the Fish finish.
5. Braai packs will be sold at the clubhouse on Saturday evening and Sunday after the race.
6. A cut off will be enforced at Saltpan's Bridge on Saturday.
7. Closing date for entries: midnight on Thursday, 15/09/2011. Late entries and registration at the FRCC clubhouse from 19h00 to 21h00 on Friday, or at Grassridge Dam from 09h00 - 10h00 on Saturday
8. Day 1 start at 11h00 at Grassridge Dam on Saturday.
9. Day 2 start at Knutsford at 09h00 on Sunday.
10. Boerewors roll for each paddler at finish of each day included in entry fee.
11. Prize giving at 13h00 at the Canoe Club on Sunday.
